

MRS COVID Decision Chart

Who	What to Do	You may return when...
Any SYMPTOMATIC individual regardless of vaccine status	Stay home and email office@monicaros.org Take a PCR Test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Symptoms have improved <u>and</u> • 24 hours have passed with no fever and no fever reducing medicine <u>and</u> • You have negative PCR results.
Any COVID POSITIVE Individual regardless of vaccine status	Stay home and isolate for at least 5 days. *date of symptom onset or positive test result is day 0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 5 days have passed since symptom onset <u>and</u> • A rapid antigen test produces a negative result <u>and</u> • Symptoms have resolved <u>and</u> • 24 hours have passed with no fever and no fever reducing medicine. • OR Isolation can end after 10 days without testing as long as the individual is fever free and symptoms are resolving. <p>*Upon return, staff and students should wear a KN95 or N95 mask and maintain 6 feet of distance from others until 14 days have passed.</p>
Staff or students who are not vaccinated OR are vaccinated and booster eligible who are considered a CLOSE CONTACT of a COVID Positive individual and <u>were not wearing a mask</u>	Stay home and quarantine Test on or after day 5 using a PCR test *date of last exposure is day 0	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 5 days have passed since LAST exposure <u>and</u> • You have no symptoms <u>and</u> • You have negative PCR results from day 5 or later. <p>*Upon return, staff and students should wear a KN95 or N95 mask and maintain 6 feet of distance from others until 14 days have passed since exposure.</p>
<p>* Staff or students who are <u>not vaccinated</u> or are <u>vaccinated and booster eligible</u> who are considered a CLOSE CONTACT of a COVID Positive Individual <u>at school</u> while masks were properly worn at the time of exposure, may continue to attend school as long as they remain asymptomatic and continue to test negative during our twice weekly PCR testing. This is considered a modified quarantine.</p>		
Staff or students who are vaccinated and not booster eligible OR are vaccinated with booster OR have tested positive in the last 90 days who are considered a CLOSE CONTACT of a COVID Positive individual	Remain at school Continue to test twice weekly Wear a well-fitting (preferably N95 or KN95) mask around others	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No quarantine required. • Remain at school. <p>*Upon return, staff and students should wear a KN95 or N95 mask and maintain 6 feet of distance from others until 14 days have passed since exposure.</p>
<p>* In the event that a member of the household is sick, we ask that when at all possible, even those that are fully vaccinated, quarantine until five days have passed since the last day of exposure.</p>		
<p>Close Contact: Anyone who was within 6 feet of a COVID positive individual for 15 minutes or more.</p>

Friday	Preschool Testing (Students not here on Thursday) Make Up Day for Absent Students Rapid Antigen School Community Clinic 9:30-11:30 am

*If your child misses their testing day or more than two consecutive days for any reason other than confirmed COVID, please come by the parking lot for a PCR test.

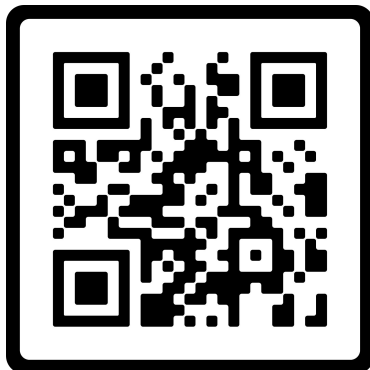
